Mildura Base Public Hospital (MBPH) is a 172- bed (level 1) tertiary teaching hospital, offering services to both public and private patients. We are a major public referral health service for the Northern Mallee sub-region of the Loddon Mallee region of Victoria, the far west region of New South Wales, and the Riverland area of South Australia. We are committed to providing exceptional patient care and fostering professional growth for our staff.

The hospital services a population of approximately 80,000 people in Mildura and the Northern Mallee area and is the second largest hospital in the Loddon Mallee healthcare region. We are also a referral center for smaller regional services including Mallee Track Health and Community Health Services and Robinvale District Health Service.

We have a number of affiliations with major Victorian universities to provide both undergraduate and post graduate Medical, Nursing and Allied health education, clinical placements and training.

Three-week extensive orientation program: A thorough orientation program to familiarise yourself with our facility, policies, procedures, values and expectations.

Preceptorship: Each participant will be paired with an experienced nurse preceptor who will provide guidance, support, and facilitate learning throughout the program.

COLLABORATIVE PROGRAM OVERVIEW:

Rotation options include:

- 8 months at Mildura Health Private Hospital (Ward and Theatre) and 4 months at Mildura Base Hospital.
- 6 months at Mildura Health Private Hospital (oncology department) and 6 months at Mildura Base Public Hospital Acute wards.
- 8 months at Mildura Base Public Hospital and 4 months at Sunraysia Community Health Services (SCHS) (District Nursing)

SCHS:

Sunraysia Community Health Services is a publicly funded health service and takes a holistic approach to the needs of clients and the community with an emphasis on continuous quality improvement and excellence in service delivery based on the principles of collaborative primary car Sunraysia Community Health Services provides services to the Sunraysia community across four streams: social health, acute health, preventative health and General Practice/Dental clinic.

As a Graduate Nurse you will work as part of our District Nursing Service team who provide general and specialised nursing and healthcare to clients to improve their health status and retain their independence to continue living at home. You will be involved in assessing the healthcare needs of clients and families, monitoring the quality of care that they receive and provide clinical interventions, including wound care management, continence care, support and monitoring of client medication, support in stoma care, and assistance with managing diabetes and other chronic diseases.

MHPH:

Mildura Health Private Hospital (MHPH) is a not for profit 50-bed private hospital including a 29-bed Medical/Surgical ward with two Enhanced Care beds, Day Procedure Unit, Day Oncology Unit and three operating theatres. Specialties include Orthopaedics, Plastic/Reconstructive, Vascular, Cardiology (pacemaker insertions), Urology, Gynaecology, Bariatric Surgery, Ear Nose and Throat, Palliative Care, Sleep Studies and General Surgery.
