Who is the Cardiac Liaison Nurse?

The Cardiac Liaison Nurse will see you while you are in hospital to provide you with education about your Cardiac diagnosis, symptoms, how to manage at home and when to get help. They assist in supporting you to get home with the right support from Community support services, such as Cardiac Rehabilitation and the Hospital Admissions Risk Program (HARP).

The Cardiac Liaison Nurse aims to:

- Provide you with information about your heart condition so that you can manage it well and communicate your needs and concerns clearly with your GP and Cardiologist.
- Help you feel confident in detecting warning signs and managing your risk factors.
- Refer you to a community-based program to support your recovery.



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
